Aggies to Aggies (A2A), a peer diversity education program, housed in the Department of Multicultural Services, seeks to promote equity, and inclusion at Texas A&M University. A2A uses an array of activities to enhance students' understandings of diversity, cultural awareness and what it means to be a socially conscious Aggie.

A2A is currently seeking volunteer peer diversity educators for the 2018-2019 academic year.

Qualifications and Requirements:

- Current undergraduate student
- Attend **six** mandatory training session during Spring 2018 semester on Thursdays from 6pm-8pm
- Attend mandatory fall (September 2018) and spring (January 2019) retreats
- Complete a reading assignment during the summer (more information will be given during the orientations)
- Maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA throughout the 2018-2019 academic year
- Demonstrate an interest, passion, commitment, and willingness to learn about diversity, equity, and inclusion
- Strong interpersonal communication skills
- Work efficiently in a diverse group of students
- Commit to **one** full academic year (September-May) of service as a peer diversity educator

2018-2019 A2A Peer Educator Responsibilities:

- Co-facilitate a minimum of **three** diversity training per semester
- Plan, promote, and co-facilitate at least **one** discussion topic related to diversity, social justice, and inclusion
- Attend mandatory weekly staff meetings on Fridays from 3pm-5pm during the academic year
- Attend bi-monthly one-on-one meetings with A2A Advisor
- Assist with the TAMU Race Identity and Social Equity Conference (RISE)
- Support the Department of Multicultural Services' programs and other related initiatives

- Access and submit application on Maroonlink
- Upload a current resume

Please submit the completed application and current resume through Maroonlink by Friday, November 3 by 5pm. Individuals who fail to submit a resume with the application before the deadline may not be considered for the position. Interviews will be scheduled and conducted between November 6-10 Decisions will be announced the week of November 13.
