

Peer Tutor Position Description Spring 2016

Department

The Department of Multicultural Services functions include: (1) enriching the student experience in transition, adaptation and graduation from Texas A&M University, and (2) supporting University efforts to educate and foster a truly multicultural environment.

Through several programs targeting the needs and interests of multicultural groups, the Department of Multicultural Services provides advocacy, mentoring, academic support, diversity education, and the enhancement of life skills.

Tutoring Program

The Tutoring Program is a free tutorial service provided by the Department of Multicultural Services. The program bridges the gap between student performance and academic expectations for students having academic difficulty. The mission of the Tutoring Program is to facilitate student academic success by providing personalized academic assistance and course-specific peer tutoring to assist students in the development of study skills essential to success in coursework. Tutoring assistance is offered for homework assignments, class work, as well as mid-term and final examinations.

Hours of Operation

Tutoring services are available four days a week - Sunday through Wednesday; 4:00 - 8:00pm, beginning the third week of the Fall semester and the second week in the Spring semester.

Position

The roles of the Peer Tutor include:

- Assisting students in the application of skills acquired in class.
- Providing support and individualized approaches to learning.
- Leading one-on-one and/or group weekly tutoring sessions.
- Participating in tutoring training as scheduled.
- Assisting in the development of materials to aid students in independent learning.
- Maintaining professionalism, promoting use of services and acting as role models.
- Keeping accurate record of hours worked, students tutored and student progress.
- Reporting to Program Administrator any issues associated with tutoring.

Qualifications/Salary/Benefits

- Current Texas A&M undergraduate students, in good academic standing.
- Completed at least two semesters at Texas A&M and received at least an "A" in one or more of the following Texas A&M courses (while at Texas A&M); BIOL111, BIOL112, CHEM 101, CHEM 102, CHEM 107, CHEM 227, MATH 131, MATH 150, MATH 141, MATH 142, MATH 151, MATH 152, MATH 166, PHYS 201, PHYS 208 and PHYS 218.
- Grade Point Ratio of at least 3.0.
- Salary \$8.50 an hour.
- 9-12 hours per week for 11 weeks in the Spring.
- Applicants must agree to a one-semester contract.

Requirements

- Approachability, welcoming, and friendly.
- Demonstrate effective verbal and written communication skills.
- Familiarity with various successful teaching and learning techniques.
- Ability to produce a valid driver's license and social security card upon request.
- Attend all mandatory workshops and events.
