- If Individual paper: include a one-paragraph abstract and a one-page CV/Resume
- If Panel proposal: include a brief description of the panel, a one-paragraph abstract for each paper presentation, a one-page CV/Resume for each panel participant.
- If proposals for alternative format: include one-page description of the session including its format and goals, as well as a one-page CV/Resume for each participant.
- Indicate Audio/Visual equipment needs.
